Child Access Routing Plan & Safety Issues / Assembly Possibility

- This year we have three faculty members supervising students arriving and leaving school.
- [School Safe Routes](#)
 - The link provides a map to show the safest way for students to get to school.
 - Parents and faculty should encourage students to walk all the way to the cross walk instead of crossing at different places.
- Students will watch a virtual assembly to promote safety.

Trustlands Training from Website

- SCC is supposed to participate in creating educational goals.
- This year each grade level chose their own literacy goal so they can target what students need.
- SCC is in charge of digital citizenship and safety of the school.

Student Dibels Data (B.O.Y.) and Current Progress

- Acadience (DIBELS) measures basic phonemic awareness, early phonics, grade-level accuracy and fluency, and basic comprehension.
 - Blue: strong indicator that the student is able to read grade-level text with proficiency (and will likely remain on grade level).
 - Green: indicator that the student is able to read grade level text with proficiency at this time (will likely need extra support to maintain proficiency).
 - Yellow: indicator that the student is struggling to read grade level text with proficiency (will likely require some level of intervention).
 - Red: strong indicator that the student is struggling to read grade level text with proficiency (will require strong interventions).
- Beginning of Year Data
 - Kindergarten Data: 73% proficient (District: 65% proficient)
 - First Data: 59% proficient (District: 59% proficient)
 - Second Data: 71% proficient (District: 72% proficient)
 - Third Data: 53% proficient (District: 73% proficient)
 - [VERY HIGH percentage of red vs. yellow students]
 - Fourth Data: 69% proficient (District: 73% proficient)
 - Fifth Data: 68% proficient (District: 64% proficient)
 - Sixth Data: 80% proficient (District: 81% proficient)

- Teams are setting overall goals and micro goals to move toward the main objective. Teachers are collecting more data using other assessment resources outside of Acadience. Each teacher uses Acadience to monitor student progress regularly.

Digital Citizenship

- We are considering the possibility of having our computer teacher hit digital citizenship in her weekly lessons.
- Parents need to be aware of what students are accessing on personal electronic devices.
- SCC will provide brief digital citizenship tips for parents that will appear in the weekly newsletter.
